

UPDATE ON THE JOHNSTOWN INCLINED PLANE REHABILITATION PROJECT

JOHNSTOWN, PA – The Cambria County Transit Authority (CamTran) is providing the following update for work completed on The Johnstown Inclined Plane Rehabilitation Project in March 2025.

March Accomplishments:

- **Completed Machining:** The South Safety Rim has been successfully machined at Speranza's Specialty Machining shop and transported to Plant Services Group (PSG).
- **Critical Components Staged:** The south safety and haul sheave wheels are now at PSG, ready for transportation to the Inclined Plane site according to the established wheel installation sequence.
- **Lower Tunnel Installation Complete:** Both North and South Lower Sheaves have been successfully installed in the lower tunnel.
- Ongoing Work: Installation of the lower north rim is currently in progress.
- **Equipment Delivery:** The north double sheave wheel and rim have been delivered to the Inclined Plane site.
- **Regulatory Coordination:** Comprehensive planning is underway for Labor and Industry Inspections and PA Rail Safety Oversight commissioning requirements.

Note: There are two complete sets of safety sheave wheels and six sets of main haul sheave wheels (three north wheels and three south wheels).
